About DevOpsDays

<u>DevOpsDays</u> is a world-wide, community-organized, not-for-profit conference series for <u>DevOps</u> practitioners. It is a series of technical conferences covering topics of software development, IT infrastructure operations, and the intersection between them. Each event is run by volunteers from the local area.

Most DevOpsDays events feature a combination of curated talks and self-organized <u>open space</u> content. Topics often include cloud, development, operations, automation, testing, security, and organizational culture.

Who Will Attend DevOpsDays Sydney?

This is a conference for software developers, IT system administrators, technology roles, open source contributors, and all other members of the wide DevOps community.

Sponsoring DevOpsDays conferences gives your organisation an opportunity to speak with some of the most active and diverse DevOps practitioners, managers, and executives from companies of all sizes and industries across Australia.

Additionally, some of the attendees are helping to shape the culture and practice of DevOps world-wide, while others are representing organisations invested in open source DevOps tools both locally and internationally.

Valuable insights into future trends, developments and new technology, products and services as well as practical advice on issues that matter most will be gained.

The conference is formally a two-day event, with the first half of each day featuring curated talks or panels and the second half of each day featuring "unconference" style open space discussions that are self-organised on the day by the attendees. On the evening of the first day we will host a social gathering. This is a great place for attendees to get to know one another better. We'll be providing food, drink (non-alcoholic) and other fun activities to participate in.

Respect and empathy are core DevOps values. DevOpsDays is dedicated to providing an environment where everyone in the DevOps community can learn and share in respectful, considerate collaboration. Sponsor Opportunities

DevOpsDays are community-focused, self-organising conferences for devops practitioners that depend on sponsor support. However, because of the nature of the event, we do not have large vendor booths or book product pitches.
